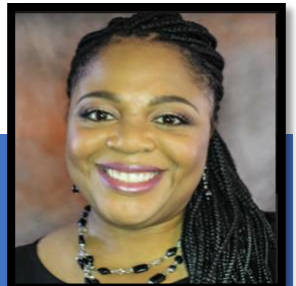
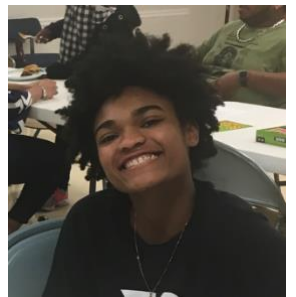
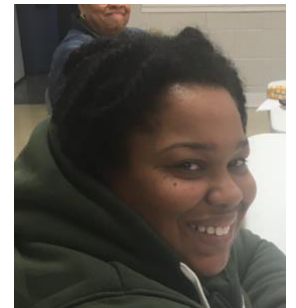

Raquel Gill, and the Bennett College Concert Choir. During the service, we raised \$7000.00 to assist Bennett college's "Stand with Bennett" campaign. It's a privilege to serve!

**February: College & Young Adult Weekend - February 7 – 10, 2019**

We kicked off Faith Point's College and Young Adult weekend with a game night on Friday, February 8 where we had fellowshiped and had some fun competition with prizes. On Sunday morning Faith Point led worship for the 8am and 11am services at Saint James. We hosted the Neo Black Society gospel choir from UNC-G. Minister Caylen Mitchell served as our dynamic preacher. Caylen is a student at Livingstone College. Faith Point Praise team led the congregation in praise and worship and we were inspired by a Black History poetry moment led by students, Jason McMasters of North Carolina A & T State University and Frank Watson of Guilford Tech Community College. We concluded the weekend volunteering at Saint James' Message and a Meal.
